## Dear Colleague

The Visor we offer is on a "something is better than nothing" basis.

Initial user feedback has been very positive. Our aim is to provide all front-line Health and Social Care Colleagues in Rugby with a PPE visor as soon as we can, and until full NHS supplies are fully available.

The visors can be washed in hot soapy water (60°C), air dried and then sprayed with alcohol or cleaned with alcohol wipe.

The elastic at the back MUST NOT be recycled. Wear fresh gloves to doing this work and a face mask.

Follow your organisational guidance on putting on and off PPE.

Safely dispose of non-recyclable items

Lastly, can you please send us feedback as we are using a Continuous Quality Improvement approach.
